1. God gave Moses the Ten Commandments.
2. The First Commandment tells us that:
 - We are to love God with all our heart, mind and soul
 - God should be the center of our life
 - “false gods” are anyone or thing that I allow to take the place of God as the center of my life.
3. The Second Commandment tells us to honor and respect the name of God.
4. The Third Commandment tells us that:
 - it is our duty to worship God at Mass on Saturday evening or Sunday
 - we are to keep holy the Lord’s day.
5. The Seventh Commandment tells us that we should not steal.
6. The Eighth Commandment tells us that we should not lie.
7. The Great Commandment was given to us by Jesus.
8. The Great Commandment tells us to love God and our neighbor as ourselves.
9. There are four marks of the Church: One, Catholic, Holy and Apostolic.
10. The birthday of the Church is celebrated on Pentecost Sunday.
11. The Pope is:
 - the spiritual leader of the Church
 - the successor of Saint Peter, the first Pope.
12. The bishop is the spiritual leader of a diocese.
13. Prayer is listening and talking to God.
14. The greatest form of prayer is the Mass.
15. The liturgical color, white, symbolizes joy. It is used at Christmas and Easter.
16. The liturgical color, green, symbolizes hope. It is used during Ordinary Time.
17. The liturgical color, red, symbolizes the Holy Spirit or martyrdom. It is used on Palm Sunday, Good Friday and Pentecost Sunday.
18. The liturgical color, purple, symbolizes penance. It is used during Lent and Advent.
19. Lent is a special time to prepare our hearts for Jesus.
20. The Stations of the Cross is a special Lenten devotion.
21. Jesus celebrated the Last Supper with his apostles on Holy Thursday.
22. Judas betrayed Jesus on Holy Thursday night.
23. Jesus rose from the dead on Easter Sunday.
24. Pentecost is fifty days after Easter Sunday.
25. Mary is the Mother of the Church.
26. The Rosary is a special prayer of devotion to Mary.
27. The traditional color used to honor Mary is blue.
28. Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist are called the Sacraments of Initiation.
29. Statues, icons, palms, ashes and rosaries are sacramentals.
