Session I-God's vision for Humanity

Pre-Session Assignment:

- ⇒ Download and bring this handout to Session I.
- ⇒ Before Session I, participants are expected to read Chapters 1-3 of Genesis from the Bible.
- \Rightarrow Reflect upon the following questions.
 - ♦ Did you know that there were two creation stories?
 - ♦ Although these stories are familiar, what was something that struck you personally for the first time?
 - ♦ In your opinion, is the Book of Genesis fact or fiction?

These questions will be discussed during Session I.

Session I: GOD'S VISION FOR HUMANITY

Chapter I: God's Vision for Humanity

Discussion questions:

- ♦ What is YOUR vision for humanity?
- ♦ What IS humanity? That is, what is a human person?
- ♦ What is it that THWARTS your vision?
- ♦ How do you execute your vision for humanity?

Chapter II: Finding God's Vision in Genesis

Discussion questions:

- ♦ Within God's vision for humanity, why is the term, "very good," significant?
- ♦ God models a day of rest in His creation plan. From your observations, is the "Sabbath" still a sacred practice?

Chapter III: Paradise: Living in Perfect Harmony

Discussion question:

♦ Imagine if you had levels of harmony that you are perfectly ok with God being God; that we are in perfect harmony with one another; and we had the gift of integrity. What would that be like?

Chapter IV—Lecture and Discussion—Paradise Lost

Discussion questions:

- ♦ How do you understand God's question to Adam and Eve: "Where are you?"
- ♦ Explain how our (personal) sin is a replay of original sin.
