# REAL PRESENCE OF JESUS IN THE EUCHARIST



Various studies in recent years have revealed a disturbing fact: less than half of people who identify as Catholics believe in the Real Presence of Jesus Christ. During these two days, José will spend time reflecting on the reality and gift of the real presence of Jesus in the Eucharist. He will explore ways Directors/Coordinators of Religious Education (D/CRES) can internalize this reality more within themselves and the lives of those with whom they minister and be open to the transforming grace that is offered to us through the Eucharist more fully. The D/CRES will have the opportunity to simulate practical lessons and activities that they can share with their students in order to help bring them to a deeper understanding and appreciation of the Eucharist intentionally enter into the Mass. The topics of the conferences are: Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity; Come and See: Leading Students to Encounter Jesus in the Eucharist; Do This In Remembrance of Me; and The Meaning of the Mass.
